## Spring Art Bazaar

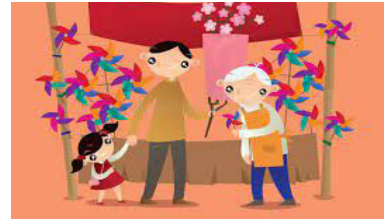

SCAMS: Are you tired of the phone calls about your "car warranty" or "lower your credit card interest rates", the "IRS" or know someone who thought the scammer was a family member in trouble? These scammers have become very sneaky and the scam Americans out of \$29 BILLION dollars annually.

How can you protect yourself and your friends?

1. Ask for a call back number! Scammers want to keep you on the phone and don't want to give you a way to contact them.
2. Don't give out ANY personal info over the

phone.

3. Think it is a family member? Hang up and call them directly to verify.

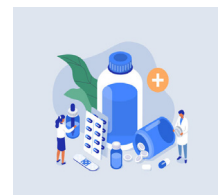

The suggested contribution for seniors is \$30 for the session.



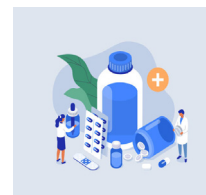
