Harvest Nutrition

From the carrot to the Brussels sprout, fall vegetables are packed with nutrients. We see them adorn the table at Thanksgiving and Christmas, but they can add to your diet year round.

Popular vegetables seen on fall menus include sweet potatoes, squash, Brussels sprouts, cauliflower, cabbage and kale. Eating a variety of these vegetables provides great sources of antioxidants, such as flavonoids and carotenoids; vitamins C, A and K; fiber, potassium, magnesium, and calcium.

A few examples of nutrient rich fall vegetables include:

Kale - Vitamins K, A, and C; Minerals

Broccoli - Antioxidants (such as carotenoids, phenolic compounds); Vitamins E and K; Minerals; Fiber

Sweet Potatoes - Vitamin A and C; Potassium; Fiber

Cauliflower - Fiber; Folate; Potassium; Carotenoids; Phenolic Compounds

Carrots - Vitamin A; Carotenoids; Vitamin K; Potassium; Thiamine; Niacin; Fiber

Brussels Sprouts - Vitamin K and C; Calcium; Fiber; Potassium; Folate

Cabbage - Vitamin C and K; Manganese. Antioxidants

Fall vegetables make great additions to salads, pizzas, and omelets. They are great for soups and stir fries. Roast different combinations together to add variety to your meals.

Recipes to try:

Brussels Sprout Salad

Mix together 1 T Cider Vinegar, 1 T Dijon Mustard, 2 t Honey, 1 small garlic clove, minced. Slowly whisk in 2 T Olive Oll until blended.

Toss together with dressing; 1 pound Brussels Sprouts (halved and thinly sliced), 1 small onion, \Box c Dried Cherries or Cranberries (chopped).

Cover and refrigerate for at least 1 hour. Stir in \square c Pecans just before serving.

Spaghetti Squash

Preheat the oven to 400°. Cut squash in half and set cut side up. Brush with olive oil and season with salt and pepper. Add other seasoning to taste. Bake cut side down until tender, 45 minutes. Scoop out spaghetti squash and top with your favorite sauce or vegetables. Sauce ideas could be marinara sauce, alfredo or other cheese sauce.


Creative Aging Workshop At the Teton County Library Mondays, November 27th -January 29th 10 - 11:30 am Free

The snow has arrived in the mountains! Hard to believe that we are almost back to winter! We wanted to share a few safety tips for everyone to keep in mind:

Hypothermia sets in FAST!

- Keep your indoor temperature set to 65 degrees or warmer.
- Layer up! 2-3 thinner layers of loose fitting clothing are warmer than one bulky layer!
- Wear the essentials! Use a hat, gloves, boots and a scarf even if you will only be out for "a minute".
- As we get older, you actually shiver less! You may not know how chilled you really are!

Falls increase this time of year!

- Wet pavement could actually be ice.... Keep a small bag of salt or cat litter near the door.
- Use shoes or boots with non-skid soles.
- If you use a cane, now is the time to replace the rubber tip if it is worn or get an ice pick attachment. Of course, ski poles are a good substitute!

Fire safety and Carbon Monoxide poisoning

- If you have a fireplace or woodstove, carbon monoxide poisoning can be a real factor!
- Install a CO2 detector, the gas is colorless and odorless.
- If you feel confused, dizzy or nauseous or have blurred vision this might be CO2 poisoning. Get fresh air ASAP and call 911!

And this is the time to put together an Emergency kit including a flashlight, extra batteries, 3 days of food supplies, first aid kit, water, and a dust mask to help filter contaminated air. Visit Teton County's website by viewing the QR code for full kit details.


