

Home Care Companion job description

A Home Care Companion is a caring person who goes to participants homes and assists with meal prep, errands, and light housekeeping help. A Home Care Companion is supervised by the Home Care Manager and the Executive Director of the Senior Center of Jackson Hole (SCJH).

Qualifications

- Completion of 8 hours of home care competency training with the SCJH RN or CAN.
- Must be physically able to perform the duties of the position, including lifting up to 40 pounds, depending on assignment requirements. Bending, stooping, transferring, turning and positioning clients and assist to ambulate.
- Must exhibit mature, responsible behavior, and understand the need for patient confidentiality
- Must possess good oral and written communication skills
- Must be able to read, write, and speak English
- Must be able to follow directions and accurately report to the home care manager any changes in client's condition
- Must be a current licensed driver, and have available properly insured, safe, and well-maintained vehicle to travel to and from assignments
- Staff who transport clients in their own personal vehicles will meet all requirements of the SCJH Transportation guidelines
- Must maintain current credentials including: CPR, first aid and blood born pathogen training.
- Establish a good working relationship with a diverse set of clients, including physically and emotionally impaired clients, developmentally delayed clients, and mentally impaired or clients with memory loss
- Carrying out the nursing delegation plan of care as directed
- Maintain strict confidentialities about all clients and cases
- Document any injuries or emergency situations as directed by Home Care Manager
- Attend and complete all educational programs
